REGIONS COVERED


1. BAHAWALPUR

- 1,000+ food boxes
- 150+ people rescued
- 40 tents distributed (in collaboration with PDMA)
- Fresh meals, fruit, water & essentials distributed

2. JHANG

- 3 medical camps organized (15 days) with free treatment
- 500+ patients treated daily
- 100 ration packs distributed (Rs. 1,015 each)
- Each pack contained: 2kg flour, 2kg rice, 1kg lentils, dishwashing & laundry soap
- Beneficiaries: 55 widowed women & 45 men
- Distribution conducted across 21 areas including Mauza Meerak Sial, Kot Khaira, and Shorkot





3. MANDI BAHAUDDIN

- 1,000+ ration bags
- Medical assistance provided to flood-affected families
- Collaboration with local volunteers for outreach

4. KHANEWAL (KABIRWALA)

- 200 mosquito nets distributed
- Medicines provided for 200 families
- Sanitary kits for women (Rs. 5,000 worth)
- **Fruits, water, fruit cakes, chocolate & juice distributed to 100 families**
- Distributed directly to 100+ flood-affected families at their homes
- Supported by District Admin/President **Muhammad Adnan**
- With the coordination of District President VLG, **Mr. Mirza Junaid Gull**

5. MULTAN

- 200 food bags (chicken + 2 roti each)
- 2 cotton biscuit packs & milk for children
- Dry ration, 50 bottled water packs
- 80 clothing bags (1 lady, 1 gents, 2 children each)

6. RAWALPINDI

- Financial support contributed to the VLG Flood Relief Initiative
- Total Support: Rs. 95,650 + Rs. 101,500 + Rs. 20,000
- Contributions utilized for purchasing food boxes, ration bags, medicines, and logistics support across flood-affected districts

OVERALL OUTCOMES & IMPACT

- Supported a total of **1,200+ families** across all regions
- Provided **free medical care to 7,500+ patients** over 15 days
- Rescued **150+ people** safely during floods
- Special Beneficiaries: **55 widowed women** supported through ration distribution
- Distributed **200 mosquito nets and medicines to 200 families**
- Strengthened inter-district collaboration through **Rawalpindi's financial support**
- Protected communities through **health, hygiene, food, and shelter support**
- Reduced suffering & **restored hope** in disaster-hit areas
